ONLINE PRIVACY STATEMENT

Security Card Services is committed to providing you the opportunity for a positive experience during your visit to our website, while respecting and striving to protect your right to privacy. Because protecting your privacy is very important, we have adopted this Privacy Statement to ensure that your rights are protected. Personal information is information that can be used to identify, locate or contact an individual. We will limit the collection and use of personal information to what is necessary to administer our business, provide you with the highest quality visit, and offer you information we think will be of interest. By submitting personal information to Security Card Services, by conducting business with Security Card Services or by using Security Card Service's services, you agree to the terms of this Privacy Statement and expressly consent to the collection, processing, use and disclosure of your personal information for the purposes set out in this Privacy Statement.

A. Collection and Use of Personal Information

"Personal Information" refers to information that identifies you directly or can reasonably be linked to you using other information. Such personal information may include your name, social security number, date of birth, postal address, telephone numbers, e-mail addresses, and financial account information.

We collect personal information from you online whenever it is provided directly to us. This includes when you make a payment, fill out an application, send us an email, complete a "Contact Us" form, enter your zip code to find a store, and submit a resume.

We may share your personal information with third party service providers to perform services on our behalf. In addition, we will also share your information throughout our family of companies and with unaffiliated third parties: (i) as required for legal or regulatory compliance, (ii) to protect our rights and property or the rights and property of other parties, (iii) in the event we sell or transfer all or a portion of our business assets, your information may be one of the business assets that are transferred as part of the transaction, (iv) during a bankruptcy proceeding, (v) for servicing, (vi) for internal business purposes, (vii) for fraud prevention, (viii) for marketing and/or to promote additional products, services, and special offers, as permitted by law, (ix) for any purpose you may request, or (x) for any other purpose that may be required or permitted by law

B. Storage and Access

Some of the personal information you provide Security Card Services may be stored on our secured server with restricted access. We reserve the right to use agents, who

are bound by strict confidentiality guidelines, to perform storage and processing functions. Only designated employees or agents who need to carry out legitimate business functions are permitted to view your personal data stored on our server. Employees or agents who violate this privacy statement are subject to disciplinary actions, up to and including termination.

C. Security

When you submit sensitive information via our Web site, your information is protected both online and off-line. All personal information you enter while on this site is encrypted and is protected with encryption software: SSL (Secure Socket Layer). While we use SSL encryption to protect sensitive information online, we also protect your information off-line. All information we receive from you is restricted in our offices and requires proper authorization to be accessed. We monitor all access requests for data and utilize intrusion detection systems to notify us of unauthorized attempts. In addition, we train our associates on our security and privacy practices. Lastly, the servers that store personally identifiable information are located in a secure locked environment and only employees who need the information to perform a specific job are granted physical access.

D. Online Tracking

We, and certain service providers operating on our behalf, may collect information using tracking technologies, including:

Browser Cookies - Cookies are small text files that are stored directly on your device web browser. We use browser cookies to personalize your visit and improve our Sites and other services. Depending on your browser version, you may be able to block or erase browser cookies. Please be aware that some features of our Sites may be unavailable to you if your browser cookies are blocked or erased.

E. Social Media Pages

From time to time, we may create and manage social media pages that include, but are not limited to, a Twitter account or a Facebook page ("Social Media Pages"). With your consent, personal information like your name, profile picture, gender, networks, user ID, list of friends, birthday, likes, education history, work history, current city, hometown, interests, relationship status, and any other information you have shared on a social media site may be collected by us.
